

Memphis Police Department Notification of Victim's/Witness' Rights 24-hour Non-emergency number

(901) 545-2677(COPS)

As a victim/witness of crime in the City of Memphis, the Memphis Police Department shall provide notice of the following information:

- 1. The victim's/witness' rights under the Tennessee Constitution, article I 35, to be free from intimidation, harassment, and abuse throughout the criminal system;
- 2. The availability, if any, of crisis intervention services, emergency and/or medical services;
- 3. The name of the law enforcement agency and telephone number;
- 4. The names and telephone numbers of public and private victim/witness assistance programs, including the state criminal injuries compensation program and programs that provide counseling, treatment, and other support services; and,
- 5. The procedural steps involved in a criminal prosecution.

VICTIM'S/WITNESS' RIGHTS

The right to confer with prosecution.

The right to be free from intimidation, harassment, and abuse throughout the criminal justice svstem.

The right to be present at all proceedings where the defendant has the right to be present. The right to be heard, when relevant, at all critical stages of the criminal justice process as defined by statute.

The right to be informed of all proceedings and the release, transfer, escape, or recapture of the accused or convicted person.

The right to a speedy trial or disposition and a prompt and final conclusion of the case after the conviction or sentence.

The right to restitution from offender.

The right to be informed of each of the rights established for victim/witness.
